

Crochet bear

Beginner-friendly
and
easy to try!



Materials

- Brown Dolls yarn × 0.5 ball
- Eye parts × 2
- Nose part × 1
- Appropriate amount of craft batting

Tools

- Size 6/0 (0.13in (3.5mm)) crochet hook
- Darning needle

Instructions

- ① Crochet the head.
 - ② Attach the yarn to the head and crochet the body from there.
 - ③ Continue crocheting from the body to the left leg.
 - ④ Attach the yarn to the body and crochet the right leg.
 - ⑤ Attach the yarn to the body and crochet both the left and right arms.
- Repeat steps 1 to 5 to make a second set.
- ⑥ Crochet the ears, mouth and tail.
 - ⑦ Attach the mouth, eyes and nose to the head. Attach the tail to the body.
 - ⑧ Place 2 pieces from steps 1 to 5 right sides facing out. Gather the layered stitches and work single crochet, then continue from the head to the arms, body, and legs. Stuff with batting while crocheting and close the round.
 - ⑨ Sew on the ears. You're done!

Try making it!




*Notes


- Make sure to crochet gently. Pulling too tightly may cause the fluff to come off.
- When attaching the parts, using a different thread (such as hand-sewing thread) or craft glue can be helpful.



Tail

1 pc.

**Stitch count chart Tail**

Row	Stitch count	Stitches to increase /decrease
2	12	+6
1	6	+4
Foundation chain	2	

*Leave the yarn tail a little long and sew it onto the body.

4	1	-1
3	2

Stitch count chart Legs

Row	Stitch count	Stitches to increase /decrease
4	1	-2
3	3	
2	3	+1
1	2

*From the second row onwards, continue crocheting without turning.

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
